I would like to welcome all cricketers and supporters of the English, Danish and Dutch Forty Club to the Amsterdamsche Cricket Club.

Over the years A.C.C. always has enjoyed a close relation to S.G.S. and as such we feel honored to host your Forty Club Triangular tournament at our grounds in Amsterdam.

A.C.C. was founded in 1921 by members of the Amsterdam Football Club with the intention to bind its members during the summer months by playing cricket.

As of the early seventies we have played our cricket on a different location to A.F.C., however, this has not prevented us of keeping a close link to our mother club.

Since 2003 our cricket club has found a new home at the sports complex “Het Loopveld”, closely located to the river Amstel.

With 3 full size cricket grounds available and our clubhouse situated in between the two main pitches we have one of the nicest cricket set ups in the country. Quite uniquely for Holland the main ground is destined for cricket only, meaning we have no interference of football or hockey and so can use it 6 months rather than 4.

The club has some 230 members and runs 4 Sunday teams and 3 on Saturday, including a ladies team. Our first team newly promoted to the highest Dutch league is looking to cement a permanent stay at the top level once again. Having won the Dutch title nine times under captaincy of A.C.C. and S.G.S. honorary member Henk van Weelde in the long past we have new ambitions with a young group of cricketers.

For this week it is up to the oldies! Hopefully your stay in Amsterdam and our ground will be blessed by fine weather, excellent cricket and good spirits.

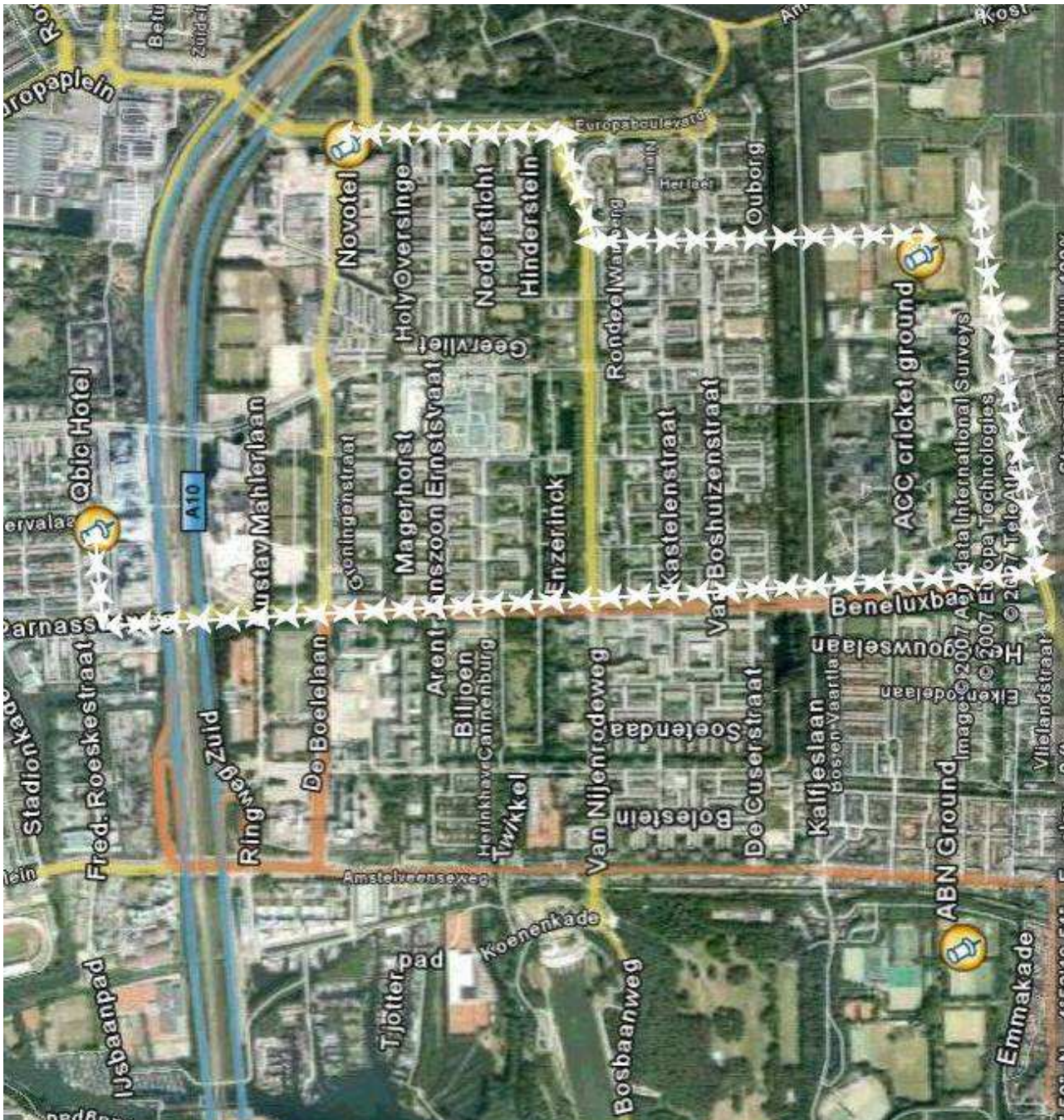

From Novotel walking to the ground is about 1700 meters. Follow the Europaboulevard past the roundabout. Then turn right into Ouborg until you get to a bridge at your left hand and cross two bridges.

From the Qbic drive west and turn left on the Parnassusweg and continue on Buitenveldertselaan. After 2,7 km turn left onto Saskia van Uylenburgweg and follow to the parking place.

Rules for the triangular tournament

The laws of cricket will apply with the following special regulation:

If the ball passes either side of the wicket and in the opinion of the umpire, is sufficiently wide to make it impossible for the striker to play the ball, from where he would normally stand at the crease, the umpire will call and signal 'wide';

1. Matches will consist of one innings per side of 45 overs
2. No player may bowl more than 9 overs
3. In the event of a bowler breaking down and being unable to complete an over, the remaining ball(s) will be bowled by another bowler. Such part of an over will count as a full over only against the bowler breaking down.
4. The side that scores the most runs will be the winner.
5. If the scores are level, the side that has lost the least number of wickets shall be the winner.
6. If still equal, the winner shall be the side with the higher scoring rate over
 - (a) 30 overs
 - (b) 20 overs
7. In the event of a tie, the side with the higher scoring rate shall be the winner.
8. If the start of the match is delayed, provided it can be completed in the allotted time, no overs shall be deducted. If play is interrupted in the first innings for less than one hour, no overs are deducted. If the time lost on the first innings exceeds one hour, the maximum length of both innings shall be reduced by one over for every FOUR minutes (or part thereof) lost. If the time is lost on the second innings, the maximum length of the second innings shall be reduced by one for every four minutes (or part thereof) lost, unless the match can be finished in the agreed time, provided the second innings does not exceed the length of the first innings. The winners will be the side with

the higher scoring rate, i.e. TOTAL RUNS PER OVER RECEIVED. If the scoring rates are equal, the winners shall be determined on the principles set out in the playing regulations 5 to 7. Neither innings shall be reduced to less than 15 overs. In any innings reduced under this regulation, the maximum number of overs per bowler shall be reduced proportionately.

NOTE. No bowler shall bowl more than one-fifth of the revised number of overs, except when the total number of overs is not divisible by five, in which case an additional over shall be allowed to a minimum number of bowlers necessary to make up the balance.

9. In the event of there being no outright winner of the Tournament, the winners will be the side with the higher scoring rate, i.e. total runs per over received.
10. In the event of no result of a match being possible, there shall be a 'bowl out' with five bowlers from each side bowling alternatively three balls at three stumps. The side with the greater number of hits will be the winner. A toss will be made for order of commencement.
11. If possible, the umpires for Tournament Matches should be from the country not participating on the day.
