## GENERAL

**Host.** The Forty Club is hosting the 2019 Quadrangular Tournament. This will be the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the original Triangular tournament.

**Venue.** The venue for the cricket will be Neston Cricket Club, Station Road, Parkgate, Neston CH64 6QJ. The website address is <https://www.nestoncricketclub.co.uk>.

**Accommodation.** The Tournament Hotel is Thornton Hall Hotel and Spa, Neston Road, Thornton Haugh, Wirral CH63 1JF. The website is <https://www.thorntonhallhotel.com>.

Reservations include full use of the hotel's spa facilities [see the hotel website].

## CRICKET

**Cricket Programme.** The detailed cricket programme is attached to this document. 2 new pink balls will be provided for each match. The used balls from each match are to be handed to the head scorer, Nathan Bradley.

**Tournament and Team Management.** Barry Aitken is the Tournament Manager. The four team managers are Jan Willem Heshusius [SGS], Neil Canham [XL], Ole Helmersen [Dansk XL] and Harmit Phull [Cricket Espana].

**Tournament Committee.** The Tournament Referee is John Sharples, manager of XL cricket. He will have a team with one representative from each nation, to apply the Rules and Playing Conditions and to resolve any disputes arising. SGS, Dansk XL and Cricket Espana are requested to pass the name of their committee representative to John Sharples.

**Cricket Bags.** The 4 changing rooms at the cricket club can be secured and it will be possible to leave cricket bags in the dressing rooms from Monday to Friday. It may also be possible to deposit them on the Sunday.

**Technical Scoring Detail.** The senior XL scorer, Nathan Bradley, will have the latest version of the Duckworth Lewis Stern programme, DLS 3.0, with him during the week and therefore in the event of inclement weather, will be able to compute both games in progress using it. To achieve this, he will require from each pair of umpires the established number of overs per side at the start of match, and minimum number of overs per side to constitute a match.

**Trophies and Cups.** Those in possession of the Tournament Trophy, the 20 over Trophy and the Gentleman's Cup are reminded to bring them to Neston and hand them to Barry Aitken.

**International Committee Meeting.** It is planned that this meeting will take place at Neston CC after 'stumps' on the Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> July.

## **ADMINISTRATION AND SOCIAL**

### **Social Programme.**

- There will be a Reception in the cricket club on the Sun 21<sup>st</sup> July, starting at 7:00pm. It is expected to last one and a half hours.
- There will be a fork supper evening in the Club on Monday evening, starting at 7:00pm.
- The Ladies Day will be on the Wednesday and will involve a tour to interesting sites in Chester.
- The Tournament Dinner will be on the Thursday evening in Thornton Hall hotel.

### **Finance.**

- **Bad Boys Match: Match Fee/ Tea Cost:** There will be a match fee of £10 per head for the players in the Bad Boys match which will be collected by Tony Fare. The cost of a cricket tea for spectators is £6.50 which will also be collected by Tony Fare.
- **Sunday Reception:** The Tournament Reception on Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> July, with a complimentary drink and a finger buffet will cost £5 per head. Team managers are requested to collect the full amount for their party of attendees on the night, and pay it to Barry Aitken.
- **Tournament Match Fees:** Coffee and biscuits on arrival on cricket days, plus a team cricket meal between the innings [approx. 2.00pm] will cost £10 per player per team payable in cash on the day, by the team manager direct to Neston CC Club Manager.
- **Tournament Lunches for Spectators:** Lunch for spectators/non players will be available at 1.00pm at the cricket club at a cost of £7. Please note that spectators/non players do not eat at the same time as the players.
- **Monday Fork Supper:** The buffet supper evening on the Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> July will be £10 a head. Team managers are requested to collect the full amount for their party of attendees on the night, and pay it to Barry Aitken.
- **Tournament Dinner:** The Tournament Dinner in the hotel will cost £30 a head. A 3 course meal is arranged, with a vegetarian option, sitting at tables of 8. Wine and drinks will be an individual purchase. The cost of the dinner will be added to the hotel bill of those staying in the hotel. All other attendees are requested to pay Barry Aitken in cash via their team manager.

**Ladies Day.** The plan is to organise a guided tour in Chester city centre, around the walls and about "The Rows". There is much to see. As there are only 9 participants the plan is that they make their own way to Chester to meet the guide. There will be a cost for the guide which will be payable by the participants on the day.

**Travel.** The journey from Thornton Hall Hotel to Neston CC is 2.4 miles and takes about 7 minutes by car. The car journey from Thornton Hall to Chester [centre] is 12 miles and takes about 30 mins.

The game will be played at King's School, Wrexham Road, Chester CH4 7QL. It will be a 35 over game starting at 1.00pm prompt with tea between the innings. The pavilion will be available from 1200 noon and we will be playing on the 1st XI pitch.

Representing the School, Mrs Tracy Elliott will be there to meet the teams. She is the Venue Manager and if needed can be contacted on 07790 844058.

Players and spectators will be able to park their vehicles in the school car park.

The match fee per player is £10 a head, payable to Tony Fare by team captains please.

The changing facilities for both teams and umpires will be in the new Sports Hall adjoining the ground. This is also where they will serve tea between innings (no spikes indoors please).

A cricket tea will be provided for 30 people (players, scorers and umpires). Teas for player's partners or any spectators will cost £6.50 per head. Tony Fare has agreed to collect both match fees and tea money.

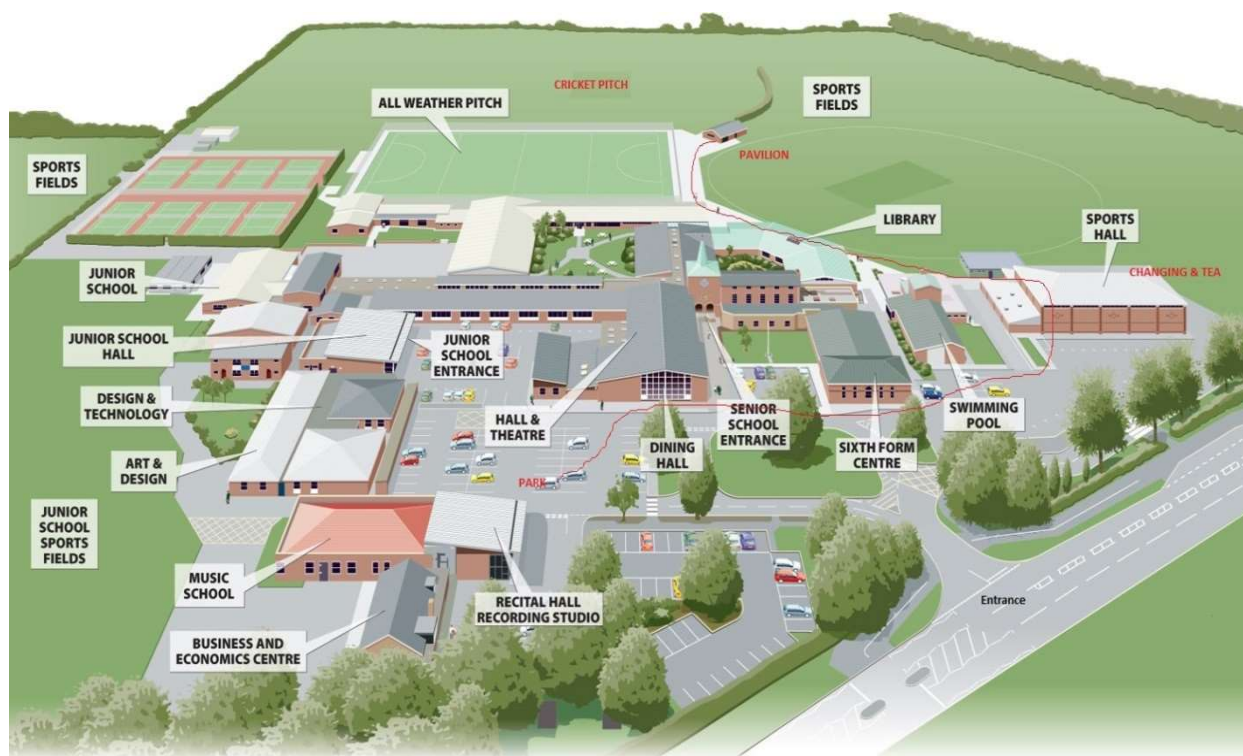
